Throw Quilt: 68" x 80"



Daisy Days

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Referring to the guilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 5" x 54" floral stripe borders

Fabric B - Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (9) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (1) 12-1/2" strip, subcut (6) 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces

Fabric D - Cut (4) 6-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 6-1/2" x 68-1/2" borders and (1) 5-1/2" x 20" strip

Cut (3) 5-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end with the 5-1/2" x 20" strip and cut into (2) 5-1/2" x 68-1/2" borders

Cut (6) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (72) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (18) 4" squares

Cut (3) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (36) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces

Fabric F - Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (18) 4" squares

Fabric G - Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces

Fabric H - Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (36) 3-1/2" squares Cut (11) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (8) 1-1/2" x 54" strips Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric I - Cut (6) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 62-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 58-1/2" borders

2. Piecing Order:

1. On the wrong side of all **Fabric E** 4" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Arrange a marked **Fabric E** 4" square right sides together with a **Fabric F** 4" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 3-1/2" square. Make a total of 36 Unit 1.









Repeat 18 times for 36 units.

3. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the **Fabrics D** and **H** 3-1/2" squares.



4. Arrange a marked **Fabric D** 3-1/2" square on an end of a **Fabric E** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end. Make a total of 36 Unit 2 $(3-1/2" \times 6-1/2" \text{ unfinished}).$









Unit 2 - Make 36

5. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric H** 3-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a Fabric B 6-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 9 Unit 3 (6-1/2" square unfinished).











Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

6. Arrange 1 Unit 3 and 4 each Units 1 and 2 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 9 Block 1 (12-1/2" square unfinished).



7. Stitch a **Fabric A** 5" x 54" strip between 2 **Fabric H** 1-1/2" x 54" strips. Trim to 7" x 52-1/2" (unfinished). Make a total of 4 **Block 2.**



8. Sew a **Fabric C** 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip between 2 **Fabric G** 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips. Make a total of 6 **Block 3** (8-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).



Block 3 - Make 6

- 9. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 10. Arrange 3 **Block 1** and 2 **Block 3** alternating in a row. Stitch into a block row. Make a total of 3 block rows (12-1/2" x 52-1/2" unfinished).

- 11. Arrange 4 **Block 2** and **3** block rows alternately in a vertical row. Stitch blocks and block rows together. Quilt center measures (52-1/2" x 62-1/2" unfinished).
- 12. Sew **Fabric I** 3-1/2" x 62-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric I** 3-1/2" x 58-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 13. Sew **Fabric D** 5-1/2" x 68-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric D** 6-1/2" x 68-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 14. The quilt measures approximately 68-1/2" x 80-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric J**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!


