GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/ pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are



virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together HST = Half Square Triangle

Basic Sewing Supplies 2 ¾ yards Wide Back backing fabric of your choice Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



(21) Warm Rain Fat Quarters

Fom (11) Fat Quarters cut (10) 5" x 5" squares. Label as **A**. From (10) Fat Quarters cut (9) 5" x 5" squares. Label as **A**.



Cinammon Grove

Cut (9) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 4 ½" x 80 ½" strips. Label as **B**.

(2) 4 ½" x 88 ½" strips. Label as **C**.

Cut (10) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.



Cream

Cut (25) 5" × WOF strips; subcut: (200) 5" × 5" squares. Label as **D**.

SEWING TECHNIQUE

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in the abbreviated form.

2-AT-A-TIME HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE METHOD (HST)

Place (2) squares RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) square. Stitch $\frac{1}{2}$ on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to create (2) HSTs. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim HSTs to the indicated size.









QUADRANT ASSEMBLY

Note: Refer to the quilt photo and diagrams for the placement of blocks. Press seams as shown. The quilt center is composed of (4) quadrants. Each quadrant measures (10) rows of (10) HSTs. Quadrants 1 and 4 are laid out the same and Quadrants 2 and 3 are laid out the same.

- 1. Use the 2-at-a-time HST method to make (400) HSTs using the $\bf A$ and $\bf D$ -squares. Trim to 4 $1\!\!\!/^2$ x 4 $1\!\!\!/^2$.
- 2. Lay out (10) rows of (10) HSTs referring to the Quadrant Diagrams.
- 3. Sew the HSTs together into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the Quadrant.
- 4. Repeat to make a total of (2) Quadrant 1 units and (2) Quadrant 2 units.

QUADRANT 1/4 DIAGRAM (MAKE 2)




QUADRANT 2/3 DIAGRAM (MAKE 2)



QUILT ASSEMBLY

5. Lay out the quadrants following the Quadrant Identification Diagram. Sew the quadrants together into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

Quadrant Identification Diagram




- 6. Sew the **B**-strips to the sides of the Quilt Center. Press toward the **B**-strips.
- 7. Sew the **C**-strips to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Press toward the **C**-strips.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

8. Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Cinnamon Grove binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
